






Camera Two cameras, one facing forward and the other backward, providing on-board footage.

Air Box This allows the engine to suck in air for it to run properly.



## Chassis

The outer "shell" of the car, which is made of one single piece of lightweight material.

> **Tires** F1 tires are wide for better grip on the track.

**Cockpit** A strong padded compartment where the driver sits.

## Side pods

These keep the engine cool by directing air through the radiators.

> A BUT

## Suspension

These contain shock absorbers—a series of springs that connect the wheels to the main body and allow the car to move more smoothly and avoid a bumpy ride.
