

HOW TO DRAW DAI




1. Start with a rounded shape like a moon. Remember to draw the base lines in pencil so you can erase them later!



2. Add some extra shapes for the chin, the neck and the shoulders. Dai has a big chin.



3. Add a couple of small circle, they'll be Dai's eyes! Now we have the base for start drawing Dai.



4. Draw the elements for the face. Under the glasses Dai's eyes look small. He has a nice nose and a shy smile.



5. Add some hair and don't forget his glasses!



6. Dress him with a cool jacket and a nice t-shirt.



7. Erase the base lines and add some extra elements (his penguin backpack and his sword are a must).



8. Add some colour. His hair has a cool purple tone and he normally dresses in red. Once you finish you are done!



9. Try to draw him with a different expression or with some other elements like this bird.







HOW TO DRAW CHIRI



1. Start with a circle for the head.



2. Add some extra shapes for the chin, the neck and the shoulders. Remember that Chiri is quite rounded.



3. Add a couple of extra circles for the eyes. We have the base for making Chiri come to life!



4. Draw the elements for the face. Big eyes, cute nose and always a big smile.



5. Add some hair and don't forget the hearing Aids!



6. Dress her in her oversized hoodie.



7. Erase the base lines and add some extra elements (Boniato usually likes to rest in her hood).



8. Add some colour. Her hair is as pink as strawberry gum and her hoodie is as yellow as the sun... Done!




9. Now you can try to draw her with a different expression or with some other elements.








HOW TO DRAW A PILLOWGOAT



1. Draw a blob. Don't worry if it's not perfect!



2. Add some extra blobs for the ears and the little legs.



3. Start drawing his face. A cute nose and a couple of closed eyes (pillowgoats sleeps more than 20 hours at day).



4. Make some fluffy fur, a couple of horns and the silliest tail you can draw.



5. Erase the sketch lines so you can see how elegant Boniato looks



6. Add some colour. Remember that he looks like vanilla ice cream and his horns are banana yellow.





7. Draw some random blobs and try to draw a pillowgoat over them, let's see how many different versions you can do! (Remember that pillowgoats can change their height and proportions, so don't worry about messing with their size).
